A 27-year financial services industry veteran, Yalung was promoted to his current role in November 2005. Before coming to the Puget Sound area, Yalung served as Regional President for Wells Fargo in Greater Arizona. His previous positions include regional manager for Wells Fargo in Northern Arizona, district manager for Metro Phoenix, Area Sales And Service manager, and assistant to the Southwest Region president and Chief Executive Officer. He joined Wells Fargo in 1983.

He serves on the board of directors of the Seattle branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco. He is a member of the Pacific Coast Banking School administrative board and the Washington Bankers Association board of directors. He is also a member of the National Board of Advisors for the University of Arizona Eller College of Business and Public Administration.
